CDHD Offering Back-to-School Immunization Clinics in Boise

Boise — With a new school year getting underway soon in most Treasure Valley districts, it's the perfect time to get kids up-to-date on their immunizations. The Central District Health Department (CDHD) is offering immunization clinics this month for kids through age 18, with evening appointments available.

Event Details

What: CDHD Immunization Clinics for Kids (from birth through age 18)

When: Monday, August 14, 21, 28 from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Where: CDHD's Boise Office | 707 N. Armstrong Place, Boise (off of Emerald, just east of Five Mile Road)

Cost: While there is no charge for immunizations themselves, an immunization administration fee is charged on a sliding fee scale depending on income level. Most insurance companies can be billed, including Medicaid. No child will be denied vaccine(s) based on ability to pay.

How: Appointments are preferred. To make an appointment on one of the designated days, a different day, or for more information, call **CDHD's Immunization Clinic at 208-327-7450**.

CDHD provides year-round vaccines to children from birth through 18 years at its Boise, McCall and Mountain Home clinics.
