Board of Health meeting to be held Friday, August 21; to include COVID-19 metrics review, Open Meeting Law training, and additional items

Ada County, ID – The Central District Health Board of Health will meet virtually for its regularly scheduled meeting on Friday, August 21 from 8:30 am to 12:30 pm. Due to the August 21 meeting, there will not be a meeting held today (Tuesday, August 18) or Tuesday, August 25. The Board will resume its weekly Tuesday meetings on September 1 at 4 pm.

The agenda for the August 21 meeting will include a review of COVID-19 metrics for Criteria for Determining Quarantine and Restriction Orders for Ada County, an Open Meeting Law training, and an Executive Session.
